Frederick G. Grieve, Ph.D., is a Professor of Psychology at Western Kentucky University and a licensed psychologist in Kentucky. He earned his doctorate in clinical psychology from the University of Memphis in 1996 and completed internships at the University of Mississippi Medical Center and Harriett Cohn Mental Health Clinic. Dr. Grieve has studied sport fan behavior since the late 1990s, publishing 52 articles and delivering over 55 presentations. He has also extensively researched eating disorders, particularly male body image, with over 20 publications and 30 presentations. A recognized mentor and researcher, he has received multiple awards, including the 2024 Outstanding Mentor for Graduate Students from the Kentucky Psychological Foundation.
