

SUMMARY OF KY SENATE SEATS AFTER 2022 PRIMARY ELECTION

All Even-Numbered Senate Districts Were Potentially on the Election ballot in 2022. Results below reflect the results of the May 17, 2022 Primary. Democrats are in [blue](#) font. Julie Raque Adams – 36 – No race; will be seated in Jan. Jefferson (part)

Ralph Alvarado – 28 – No race; will be seated in Jan. Bath, Clark, Fayette (part), Menifee and Montgomery

[Karen Berg](#) – 26 – Will face James Peden in Nov. Jefferson (part)

Jared Carpenter – 34 – Will face [Susan Cintra](#) in Nov. Fayette (part) and Madison

Danny Carroll – 2 – No race; will be seated in Jan. - Ballard, Carlisle, Marshall, Livingston and McCracken

Matt Castlen – 8 – Retiring. Gary Boswell will be seated - Daviess, Hancock, McLean

Don Douglas – 22 – Will face [Chuck Eddy](#) in Nov. Garrard, Jessamine and Fayette (part)

C. B. Embry, Jr. – 6 – Retiring. Primary winner Lindsey Tichenor will be seated - Oldham, Trimble and Jefferson (part)

Jimmy Higdon – 14 – No race; will be seated in Jan. Marion, Nelson, Spencer, Larue and Washington

Paul Hornback – 20 – Retiring. Gex “Jay” Williams will face [Teresa Barton](#) in Nov. Boone (part), Carroll, Franklin, Gallatin, Kenton (part) and Owen

Alice Forgy Kerr – 12 – Retiring. Amanda Bledsoe will face [Paula Setser-Kissick](#) in Nov. Boyle, Fayette (part), Mercer and Woodford

Robby Mills – 4 – Will face [Bruce Pritchett](#) in Nov. Henderson, Hopkins, Union and Webster

Mike Nemes – 38 – No race; will be seated in Jan. Jefferson (part)

[Dennis Parrett](#) – 10 – Retiring. Matthew Deneen will be seated in Jan. Hardin and Jefferson (part)

Wil Schroder – 24 – Retiring. Shelley Frommeyer will face [Rene Heinrich](#) in Nov. Bracken, Campbell, Kenton (part) and Pendleton

Brandon Smith – 30 – Will face [Sid Allen](#) in Nov. Breathitt, Estill, Lee, Leslie, Magoffin, Morgan, Perry, Powell and Wolfe

[Robin Webb](#) – 18 – No race; will be seated in Jan. Boyd, Carter, Greenup and Lewis

Mike Wilson – 32 – No race; will be seated in Jan. Logan, Simpson, Todd and Warren (part)

Max Wise – 16 – [Justy Engle](#) has withdrawn from the race; Sen. Wise will be seated in Jan. Adair, Allen, Metcalfe, Monroe, Taylor, and Warren (part)

8* Incumbents had no challengers, so they will return in January. They are Senators: Julie Raque Adams (SD 36), Ralph Alvarado (SD 28), Danny Carroll (SD 2), Jimmy Higdon (SD 14), Mike Nemes (SD 38), [Robin Webb](#) (SD 18), and Mike Wilson (SD 32). *Max Wise (SD 16) had a Democratic opponent who withdrew in July; Sen. Wise will return in January.

6 Incumbents are retiring and did not file to run in 2022. They are Senators: Matt Castlen (SD 8), C. B. Embry (SD 6), Paul Hornback (SD 20), Alice Forgy Kerr (SD 12), [Dennis Parrett](#) (SD 10) and Wil Schroder (SD 24).

5 Incumbents have challengers on November 8th. They are Senators: [Karen Berg](#) (SD 26), Jared Carpenter (SD 34), Donald Douglas (SD 22), Robby Mills (SD 4) and Brandon Smith (SD 30).

In 3 of the seats where the Senator is retiring, the winner of the Primary has no opposition in November, so has been elected to serve in January as the new Senator. They are Senators-Elect: Lindsey Tichenor (SD 6); Gary Boswell (SD 8); and Matthew Deneen (SD 10).

In 3 of the seats where the Senator is retiring, there will be a race in November. Those Senate Districts are SD 12 – Amanda Bledsoe vs. [Paula Setser-Kissick](#); SD 20 – Gex “Jay” Williams vs. [Teresa Barton](#); and SD 24 – Shelley Frommeyer vs. [Rene Heinrich](#).
